to authorize the conveyance of certain lands to the Metropolitan Toronto and Region Conservation Authority


The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton, ENACTS as follows:

1. The transfer of the lands described in Schedule A hereto from The Corporation of the City of Brampton to The Metropolitan Toronto and Region Conservation Authority for the sum of \$2.00 is hereby authorized.
2. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to execute all documents approved by the City Solicitor necessary to effect the said transfer.

SCHEDULE A TO BY-LAW 276-85

The lands situated in the City of Brampton, in the Regional Municipality of Peel (formerly in the Town of Brampton, County of Peel) and being composed of:

FIRSTLY: The part of Lot 6, Concession 1, East of Hurontario Street of the geographic township of Chinguacousy, designated as parts 4, 6 & 7 on reference plan 43R-11976;

SECONDLY: The part of Hemlock Street according to Registered Plan BR-13, which street was stopped up and closed by by-law 3-83, designated as parts 8, 9 and 10 on reference plan 43R-11976; and

THIRDLY: The part of Block H according to Registered Plan BR-13 and the part of Lot 13 according to Registered Plan BR-26, designated as part 15 on reference plan 43R-11976,

all subject to an easement as set out in Instrument 28270 (Brampton).
