

## THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON

## **BY-LAW**

Number 277 - 2011

To prevent the application of part lot control to part of Registered Plan 43M - 1822

**WHEREAS** subsection 50(5) of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. c. P.13, as amended, has imposed part lot control on all lands within registered plans within the City;

**AND WHEREAS**, pursuant to subsection 50(7) of the *Planning Act*, the Council of a municipality may, by by-law, provide that subsection 50(5) of the *Planning Act* does not apply to land within such registered plan or plans of subdivision or parts thereof, as are designated in the by-law;

**AND WHEREAS,** the application for an exemption from part lot control, pursuant to subsection 50(7) of the *Planning* Act, on the lands described below, for the purposes of creating maintenance easements, is to the satisfaction of the City of Brampton;

**NOW THEREFORE,** The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:** 

1. THAT subsection 50(5) of the *Planning Act* does not apply to the following lands:

City of Brampton, Regional Municipality of Peel, being composed of:

The whole of Lots 115 to 118, inclusive, 120, 121, 125, 136, 173, 189, 194, 195, 197 and the whole of Blocks 200 and 201 on Registered Plan 43M-1822.

2. THAT, pursuant to subsection 50(7.3) of the *Planning Act*, this by-law shall expire at the end of the business day on September 28, 2014.
