(Part of Lot 9, Concession 2 E.H.S.)

The Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS As  $\hat{F}$  of lows:

- 1. Schedule A to By-law 861, as specifically amended by By-laws 877, 249-75, 94-76 and 244-76, is hereby further amended by changing from RESIDENTIAL MULTIPLE FIRST DENSITY ATTACHED (RMI (A)) to RESIDENTIAL FIFTH DENSITY (R5D), RESIDENTIAL MULTIPLE (RMA), COMMERCIAL FIVE-SECTION 252 (C5A-SECTION 252) CONSERVATION AND "REENBELT (G), and RESIDENTIAL MULTIPLE HOLDING (RMA (H)) the zoning designations of the lands shown outlined on Schedule A to this by-law, such land being part of Lot 9, Concession 2 E.H.S. in the former Township of Chinguacousy, now in the City of Brampton.
- 2. Schedule A to this By-law is hereby attached to By-law 861 and forms part of By-law 861.
- 3. By-law 861 is hereby further amended by adding thereto the following section:
  - "252 The lands designated as C5A-SECTION 252 on Schedule A hereto attached;
    - 252.1 shall only be used for the purposes permitted in a C5A zone;
    - 252.2 shall be subject to the following restrictions and requirements:
      - 1) minimum frontage: 31 metres
      - 2) minimum lot or block area: 1160 square metres.
      - 3) minimum front yard: 15 metres.

- 4) minimum side yard: 9 metres
- 5) minimum rear yard: 6 metres
- 6) minimum side yard flanking street 9 metres.
- 7) maximum coverage of building of the lot or block area: 25%
- 8) a minimum of 5.0 parking spaces shall be provided for every 100 square metres of gross floor area.
- 9) each parking space shall not be less than 17.6 square metres, exclusive of driveways or aisles.
- 252.3 shall also be subject to the restrictions and requirements relating to a C5A zone which are not in conflict with the ones set out in section 252.2"
- 4. This By-law shall not come into force without the approval of the Ontario Municipal Board.


