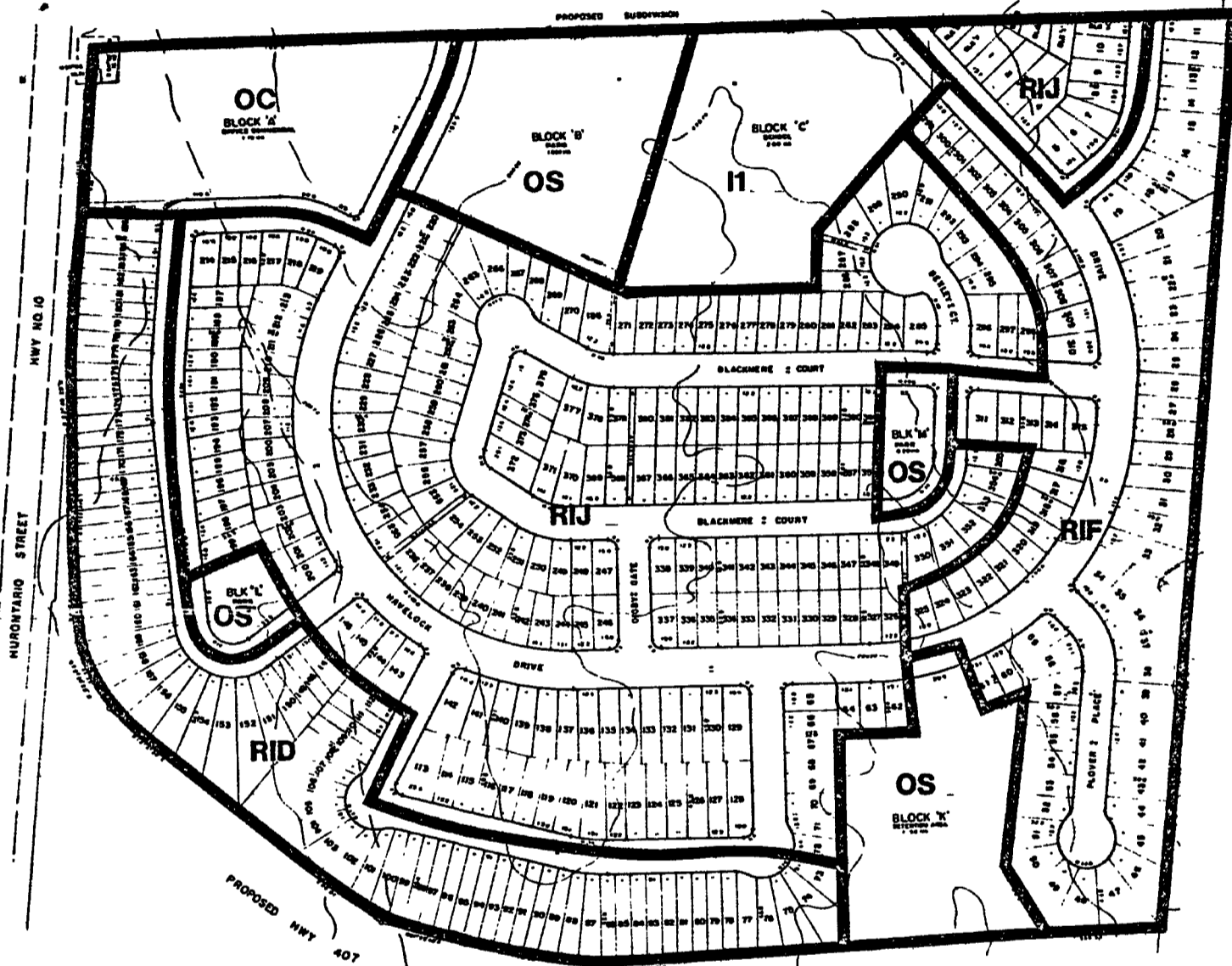

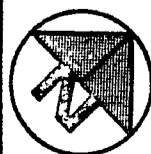




CON. I.E.H.S. LOT 13



DECLARATION


I, RALPH A. EVERETT, of the City of Brampton, in the Region
