BY-LAW

Number 280-86

To amend By-law 139-84 (part of Lots 13 and 14, Concession 1, E.H.S., in the geographic Township of Toronto)

The council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. By-law 139-84, as amended, is hereby amended:

(1) by changing, on Sheet 7 of Schedule A thereto, the zoning designation of the lands shown outlined on Schedule A to this by-law from RECREATIONAL COMMERCIAL (RC) to RESIDENTIAL ESTATE ONE - SECTION 643 (RE1 - SECTION 643).

(2) by adding thereto the following section:

"643 The lands designated RE1 - SECTION 643 on Sheet 7 of Schedule A hereto:

643.1 shall only be used for:


(1) the purposes permitted by section 11.1.1(1)

643.2 shall be subject to the following requirements and restrictions:

(1) Minimum lot area - 0.338 hectares
(2) Minimum lot width - 62 metres


643.3 shall also be subject to the requirements and restrictions relating to the RE1 zone and all the general provisions of this by-law which are not in conflict with the ones set out in section 643.2."




DECLARATION
