BY-LAW

Number 281-85

To establish a local
advisory committee under
the Ontario Heritage Act

WHEREAS the council of a municipality, in accordance with section 28 of the Ontario Heritage Act (R.S.O. 1980, c. 337, as amended), may, by by-law, establish a local advisory committee to be known as the Local Architectural Conservation Advisory Committee;


AND WHEREAS the council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton deems it expedient to establish such a committee;

NOW THEREFORE the council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. A local advisory committee, to be known as the Local Architectural Conservation Advisory Committee (LACAC) and also as the Brampton Heritage Board, is hereby established.
2. The Brampton Heritage Board shall be composed of not fewer than 5, and not more than 9, members, to be appointed by a resolution of the council.
3. (1) The Brampton Heritage Board shall advise and assist the council on all matters relating to Parts IV and V of the Ontario Heritage Act (R.S.O. 1980, c. 337; as amended).
- (2) The aims and objectives of the Brampton Heritage Board shall be to search out and assess, and to make recommendations in respect of the designation of, any property which, in the opinion of the Brampton Heritage Board, has historic or architectural merit.
4. By-laws 215-76, 75-77 and 49-79 are hereby repealed.
