To amend By-law 200-82 (Part of Lot 4, Concession 1, E.H.S. geographic Township of Chinguacousy)

The council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. By-law 200-82, as amended, is hereby further amended

- (1) by_changing on sheet 30 of Schedule A, thereto, the zoning designation of the land outlined on Schedule A to this by-law from HIGHWAY COMMERCIAL ONE (HC1) to HIGHWAY COMMERCIAL TWO -SECTION 290 (HC2-SECTION 290) the lands being part of Lot 4, Concession 1, East of Hurontario Street, in the geographic Township of Chinguacousy.
- (2) by adding thereto, as Schedule C Section 290, Schedule B to this by-law.
- (3) by adding to Section 3.2, thereof, as a plan included in ScheduleC, the following:

"Schedule C - Section 290"

(4) by adding thereto the following section:

- "290 The lands designated HC2-Section 290 on sheet 30 of Schedule A to this by-law
- 290.1 shall only be used for the following purposes:

(1) a gas bar

(2) only in conjunction with a gas bar, a retail establishment having no outside storage

- the gross commercial floor area devoted to a retail establishment shall not exceed 250 square metres;
- (2) the gross commercial floor area of the kiosk shall not exceed 14 square metres;
- (3) all buildings shall be located within the areas shown as BUILDING AREA on Schedule C - Section 290;
- (4) landscaped open space shall be provided and maintained in the areas shown as LANDSCAPED OPEN SPACE on Schedule C - Section 290;
- (5) the maximum height of all buildings and structures shall not exceed 1 storey;
- (6) a garbage and refuse storage enclosure shall be provided and maintained in the area shown as Garbage Enclosure on Schedule C - Section 290, and
- (7) a 1.8 metre masonry wall shall be provided and maintained in those areas shown as PRIVACY FENCE on Schedule C - Section 290.
- 290.3 shall be subject to the requirements and restrictions relating to the HC2 zone and all general provisions of this by-law which are not in conflict with the ones set out in Section 290.2."

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME, and PASSED, in OPEN COUNCIL,




