



THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON

BY-LAW

Number 289-97

A by-law to amend By-law 51-89, as amended, being a by-law to constitute and appoint a Committee of Adjustment and to provide for compensation to the Members of the Committee of Adjustment

Whereas By-law 51-89, as amended, provides for the constitution of a Committee of Adjustment, for the appointment of members to the Committee of Adjustment and for compensation paid to Members of the Committee;

And whereas pursuant to Resolution 97-805 of The Regional Municipality of Peel, the authority of Regional Council to give consents under Section 53 of *The Planning Act*, RSO 1990, c.P.13, as amended, with respect to land situated in the City of Brampton, was delegated to the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton effective as of and from the 1st day of January, 1998;

And whereas it is deemed appropriate that authority to give such consents should be subdelegated to the Committee of Adjustment;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. That By-law 51-89, as amended, is further amended to renumber Section 2 as Section 2.1 and to add Section 2.2, as follows:

“2.2 That the Council delegates to the Committee of Adjustment the authority to give consents under Section 53 of *The Planning Act*, RSO 1990, c.P.13.

2. That Schedule A to By-law 51-89, as amended, is hereby deleted and the following substituted therefor:

3. That Schedule B to By-law 51-89, as amended, is hereby deleted and the following substituted therefor:

\$100.00 per meeting”
