To prevent the application of part lot control to part of Registered Plan 43M - 1564

**WHEREAS** subsection 50(5) of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. c. P.13, as amended, has imposed part lot control on all lands within registered plans within the City;

**AND WHEREAS,** pursuant to subsection 50(7) of the *Planning Act*, the Council of a municipality may, by by-law, provide that subsection 50(5) of the *Planning Act* does not apply to land within such registered plan or plans of subdivision or parts thereof, as are designated in the by-law;

**AND WHEREAS**, the application for an exemption from part lot control, pursuant to subsection 50(7) of the Planning Act, on the lands described below, for the purpose of creating a maintenance easement to facilitate a single detached dwelling unit, is to the satisfaction of the City of Brampton;

NOW THEREFORE, The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT subsection 50(5) of the Planning Act does not apply to the following lands:

City of Brampton, Regional Municipality of Peel, being composed of:

The whole of Lot 127 on Registered Plan 43M-1564.

2. THAT, pursuant to subsection 50(7.3) of the *Planning Act*, this by-law shall expire on September 26<sup>th</sup>, 2006.

**READ** a **FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME** and **PASSED** in Open Council this 26<sup>th</sup> day of September 2005.
