BY-LAW

Number 289-2006

To amend By-Law 274-2004, An Interim Control By-Law
Applicable to Part of the Area Subject to Zoning By-Law 270-2004

The Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. By-Law 274-2004 is hereby amended as follows:
 - a) Section 1 is amended by adding, before the words "The lands described as part of Lot 6, Concession 1, E.H.S.," the following:

"Except as provided for in Section 1.3,"
 - b) The following is added as Section 1.3:


"1.3 The lands described as part of Lot 5, Concession 1, E.H.S., known municipally as 111 Queen Street East and 113 Queen Street East, and referenced as the "Lands Subject to Specific Exemption from Interim Control By-Law 274-2004", as amended by By-Law 289-2006 and as outlined on Schedule A to this by-law shall only permit a parking lot in association with a personal service shop."

READ a FIRST, SECOND AND THIRD TIME, and PASSED, in OPEN COUNCIL, this 11 day of September, 2006.

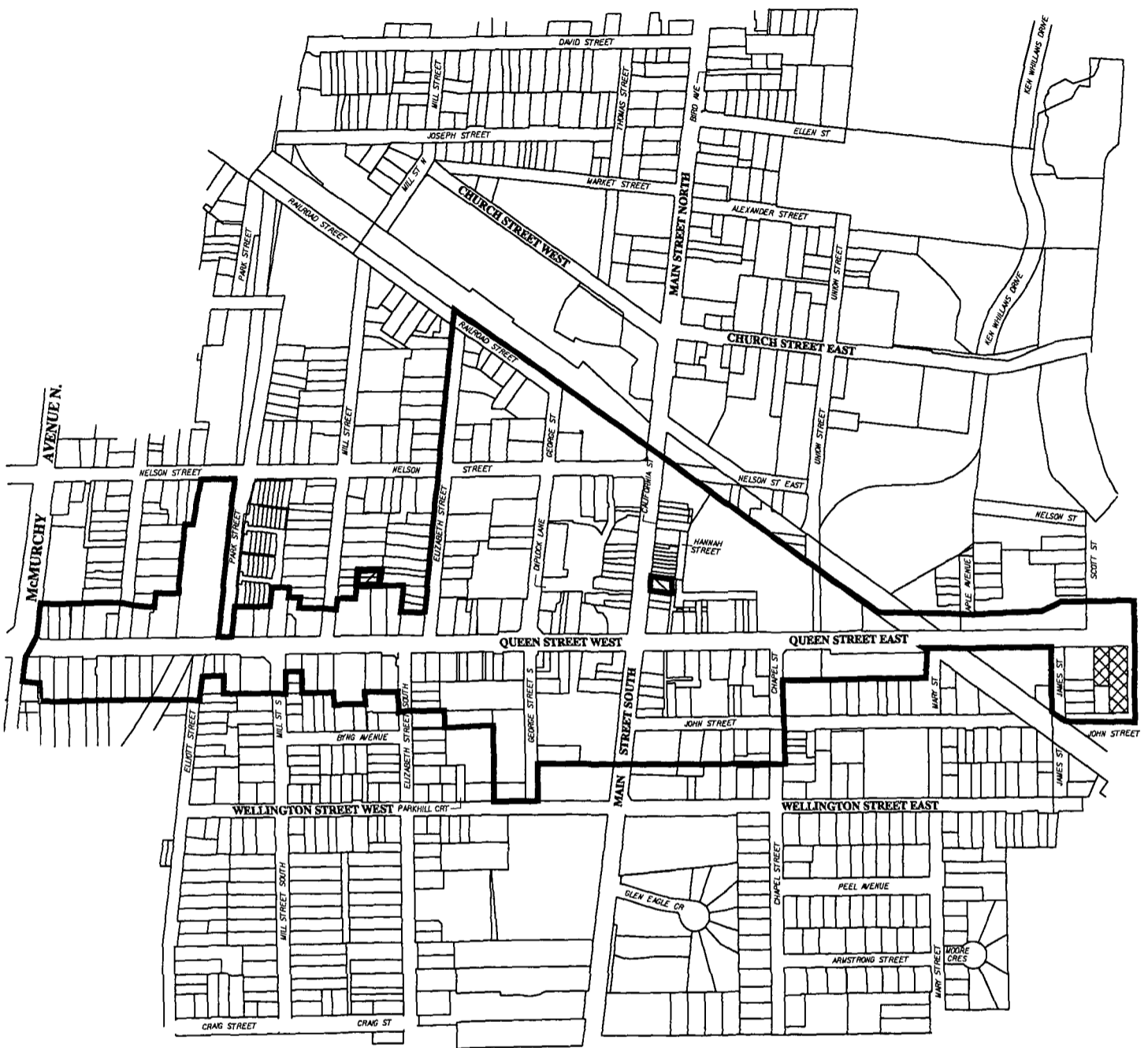

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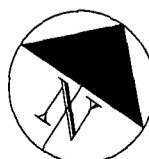
