



THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON

BY-LAW

Number 290-88

To amend By-law 269-88

WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton passed By-law 269-88 on the 28th day of November, 1988, to prevent the application of part lot control to certain lands;

AND WHEREAS By-law 269-88 incorrectly contained references to registered plan 43M-785, which should have been references to registered plan 43M-775;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton hereby ENACTS as follows:

1. By-law 269-88 is hereby amended:
 - (1) by deleting "Registered Plans 43M-775 and 43M-785" from the title to the By-law and by substituting therefore "Registered Plan 43M-775"; and
 - (2) by deleting "Lots 69 to 76, both inclusive on registered Plan 43M-785" from Schedule A to the by-law and by substituting therefore "Lots 69 to 76, both inclusive, on registered Plan 43M-775".
2. This By-law shall come into force upon approval thereof by The Regional Municipality of Peel.
