A By-law to amend By-law 250-82 to appoint a Poundkeeper and to carry out the operation of the Brampton Animal Shelter and Pound

The Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Section 12 of By-law 250-82, as amended, is hereby deleted and the following section shall be substituted therefor:

"12. The Poundkeeper is hereby authorized to charge the following fees for service provided:

i)	Adoption:	Dogs	\$35.00
		Cats	\$20.00
ii)	Vacinations		\$10.00
iii)	Placing for Adoption:	Dogs Cats	\$25.00 \$20.00
	Litter of Puppies or Kittens		\$ 5.00 each
iv)	Euthanasia and Cremation:	Dogs Cats	\$35.00 \$25.00
V)	Cremation only:	Dogs Cats	\$15.00 \$10.00
vi)	Private Cremation:	Dogs Cats	\$50.00 \$30.00
vii)	Urn		\$10.00
viii)	Quarantine:	Dogs Cats	\$8.00/day or part thereof \$5.00 " "
ix)	Trap Rentals	+	\$ 1.00/day \$25.00 deposit

x) Impound Fees:

Dogs - 1st offence \$15.00/day or part thereof

2nd offence \$20.00 " "
3rd Offence \$25.00 " "
4th Offence \$50.00 " "

Cats \$5.00/day or part thereof

xi) Board Fees:

Dogs \$8.00/day or part thereof Cats \$5.00/day or part thereof"

- 2. Section 13 of By-law 250-82 is hereby deleted and the following section shall be substituted therefor:
 - "13. All female dogs and cats purchased from the Animal Shelter shall, if not already done, be spayed or neutered and the operation must be performed by a veterinarian whose office is in the City of Brampton. The spaying or neutering must be done within 90 days of the date of purchase from the Pound or at the recommendation of the examining veterinarian. The City will subsidize to the veterinarian the following amounts:

Canine Neuter - \$30.00 Thirty Dollars
Canine Spay - \$30.00 Thirty Dollars
Feline Spay - \$20.00 Twenty Dollars
Feline Neuter - \$15.00 Fifteen Dollars"
