The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton has determined that the land described herein is no longer required for the purposes of the Municipality.

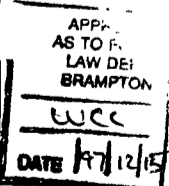
The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. The part of Block 167, Registered Plan 43M-521 abutting the rear limit of the property known municipally as 26 Christie Drive highlighted on the sketch attached as Schedule A to this by-law is hereby declared surplus. The sale of the land to Paddy Ann McHaffie at a price of \$5.74 per square foot plus legal, survey and landscaping costs is hereby authorized.
2. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to execute all documents approved by the City Solicitor that in his opinion are necessary to effect the transfer of the land described in this by-law.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 15th day of December, 1997.
