BY-LAW

Number 298-2004

To authorize the execution of Indemnity Agreements with City Employees

WHEREAS The Corporation of the City of Brampton is periodically involved in litigation regarding the termination of employees;

AND WHEREAS legal counsel retained by the City or employed by the City may require statements from current City employees regarding the former employee,

AND WHEREAS the City wishes to indemnify such current employees against subsequent legal action taken against them by the former employee;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton enacts as follows:

- (1) The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to execute indemnity agreements, in a form satisfactory to the City Solicitor, on behalf of the Corporation of the City of Brampton, with any employee of the Corporation of the City of Brampton who has provided statements for litigation involving the termination of an employee, in order to indemnify the current employee against any claims against him/her by a former employee, and including such conditions as, the information provided by these employees be truthful and in good faith.
