
To authorize the purchase of
certain lands for the purpose of
road widening

Section 6 of the *Municipal Act 2001* authorizes the Council of every corporation to pass a by-law for acquiring or expropriating any land required for the purposes of the corporation. The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton has determined that it is necessary and in the interest of The Corporation of the City of Brampton to acquire the lands herein described for road widening purposes.


NOW THEREFORE The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. The purchase of the lands described as that part of Lot 17, Concession 5, East of Hurontario Street, as in CH26201 except 147837VS, in the City of Brampton, for the purposes of road widening, is hereby authorized.
2. The Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized to execute on behalf of The Corporation of the City of Brampton an agreement of purchase and sale, on terms and conditions acceptable to the Commissioner of Works and Transportation and in a form approved by the City Solicitor, between vendors, Sarah Margaret Archdekin *et al*, and purchaser, The Corporation of the City of Brampton, at a purchase price of \$345,000.00 plus Land Transfer Tax, together with all other documents that in the opinion of the City Solicitor are necessary to effect the purchase of the said land.
3. The funds for the acquisition plus \$45,000.00 for demolition and decommissioning work shall be taken from capital project account #044040.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 26th day of September, 2005.
