BY-LAW

Number 306-2012

To Stop Up and Close and Declare Surplus a vacant road parcel located on the northwest corner of Castlemore Road and Clarkway Drive

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient in the interest of The Corporation of the City of Brampton that a vacant land parcel, being part of the Original Castlemore Road Allowance and having an area slightly in excess of one-quarter acre, located on the northwest corner of Castlemore Road, and Clarkway Drive and being Part of the original road allowance between Lots 10 and 11 Concession 10, ND, as illustrated on attached Schedule A, be declared surplus to the requirements of the City of Brampton;

WHEREAS this part of the original Castlemore Road road allowance will no longer be required for road purposes, and will serve no other municipal purposes when the newly aligned Castlemore Road is completed and opened as a public highway;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton has heard in person or by counsel, solicitor or agent, all persons claiming that their land will be prejudicially affected by this by-law and who applied to be heard;



NOW THEREFORE The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. THAT the vacant parcel of City property located on the northwest corner of Castlemore Road and Clarkway Drive as illustrated on Schedule A and being Part of the original road allowance between Lots 10 and 11, Concession 10, ND, be stopped up and closed and declared surplus to the City's requirements.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 24th day of October 2012.
