

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON

BY-LAW

Number 307-2004

To prevent the application of part lot control to part of Registered Plan 43M - 1633

WHEREAS subsection 50(5) of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. c. P.13, as amended, has imposed part lot control on all lands within registered plans within the City;

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to subsection 50(7) of the *Planning Act*, the Council of a municipality may, by by-law, provide that subsection 50(5) of the *Planning Act* does not apply to land within such registered plan or plans of subdivision or parts thereof, as are designated in the by-law;

AND WHEREAS, the application for an exemption from part lot control, pursuant to subsection 50(7) of the *Planning* Act, on the lands described below, for the purpose of creating maintenance easements, is to the satisfaction of the City of Brampton;

NOW THEREFORE, The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT subsection 50(5) of the *Planning Act* does not apply to the following lands:

City of Brampton, Regional Municipality of Peel, being composed of:

The whole of lots 19, 20, 22-31 inclusive, 33-35 inclusive, 37, 38, 40, 41, 43, 44, 46, 48, 49, 51, 53, 54, 56-59 inclusive, 62-65 inclusive, 67-69 inclusive, 72-74 inclusive, 72-74 inclusive, 72-74 inclusive, 93-98 i

2. THAT, pursuant to subsection 50(7.3) of the *Planning Act*, this by-law shall expire on September 27th, 2005.
