BY-LAW

To prevent the application of part lot control to part of Registered Plan 43M - 1633

WHEREAS subsection 50(5) of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. c. P.13, as amended, has imposed part lot control on all lands within registered plans within the City;

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to subsection 50(7) of the *Planning Act*, the Council of a municipality may, by by-law, provide that subsection 50(5) of the *Planning Act* does not apply to land within such registered plan or plans of subdivision or parts thereof, as are designated in the by-law;

AND WHEREAS, the application for an exemption from part lot control, pursuant to subsection 50(7) of the *Planning* Act, on the lands described below, for the purpose of creating maintenance easements, is to the satisfaction of the City of Brampton;

NOW THEREFORE, The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. THAT subsection 50(5) of the *Planning Act* does not apply to the following lands:

City of Brampton, Regional Municipality of Peel, being composed of:

The whole of lots 111, 113 – 115 inclusive, 117 – 119 inclusive, 121 – 123 inclusive, 125 – 127 inclusive, 129 – 131 inclusive, 134 – 138 inclusive, 140 – 142 inclusive, 144 – 146 inclusive, 148 – 151 inclusive, 153 – 159 inclusive, 161 – 163 inclusive, 165 – 167 inclusive, 170, 171, 174 – 185 inclusive, 187 – 189 inclusive, 191, 193, 194, 196 – 198 inclusive, 201 – 204 inclusive, 206 – 209 inclusive, 211 – 228 inclusive, 230 – 233 inclusive, 235 – 237 inclusive, 239 – 241 inclusive, 243 – 245 inclusive, 293, 294, 296 – 298 inclusive, 300 – 302 inclusive, 304 – 306 inclusive, on Registered Plan 43M-1633;

2. THAT, pursuant to subsection 50(7.3) of the *Planning Act*, this by-law shall expire on September 27th, 2005.
