

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON

BY-LAW

Number 309-83-

To prevent the application of part lot control to certain lands within Brampton.

WHEREAS subsection 49 (5) of the <u>Planning Act</u>, 1983, has imposed part lot control on all lands within registered plans within the City;

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to subsection 49 (7) of the <u>Planning Act, 1983</u>, the council of the municipality may by by-law provide that part lot control does not apply to lands within such registered plans or parts thereof as are designated in the by-law;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

- 1. Subsection 5 of section 49 of the <u>Planning Act</u>, 1983, does not apply to the land that is described in Schedule A to this by-law.
- 2. This by-law shall come into force upon approval thereof by the Regional Municipality of Peel.
