BY-LAW

To authorize the acquisition of the Bovaird property

WHEREAS Mossie E. Bovaird has agreed to give to the City of Brampton the property known as Bovaird House and surrounding lands, being the part of Lot 10, Concession 2, East of Hurontario Street designated as Part 1 on reference plan 43R-4637, to be used as parkland.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:


- The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to execute all documents approved by the City Solicitor necessary to effect the conveyance of the part of Lot 10, Concession 2, East of Hurontario Street in the City of Brampton, designated as part 1 on reference plan 43R-4637.
- The City of Brampton shall use the lands as a park for passive recreation, shall maintain the house on the lands as an historic site, and shall erect and maintain a commemorative plaque on the site honouring the William Bovaird family, and the deed conveying the lands shall contain the restrictive covenants to this effect.
- The payment from the cash in lieu of parkland account of all legal and appraisal fees associated with this acquisition is hereby authorized.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 16th day of October, 1985.
