BY-LAW

Number 310-2003

A By-law to amend By-law 7-92 a By-law which Regulates Licensing of Dogs and Animal Control in the City of Brampton

The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

- 1. By-law 7-92, the Dog Licensing and Animal Control By-law, is hereby amended as follows:
 - (1) Section 21 is deleted and the following substituted therefor:

21. STERILIZATION

- (a) Any person who adopts a dog or cat from the City shall ensure the dog or cat is spayed or neutered by a veterinarian of the owner's choice, within 42 days of adoption or by the time the animal becomes 5 (five) months of age.
- (b) Where a veterinarian is of the opinion that the surgery is detrimental to the health of the animal, which opinion is provided in writing to the Animal Services, the animal in question is exempt from sterilization.
- (c) The city will refund any person who has adopted a dog or cat from the City a Sterilization Rebate in the amount set out in Schedule 1 to this by-law, provided that all required documentation, as determined by the Animal Service Section, is received by the Animal Service Section.
- (2) Schedule 1 to By-law 7-92 is amended by adding the following:

Sterilization Rebate:

• Cats \$40.00

• Dogs \$50.00
