# AMENDMENT NUMBER OP93-172 TO THE OFFICIAL PLAN OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON PLANNING AREA

### 1.0 <u>PURPOSE</u>:

The purpose of this amendment is to amend the City of Brampton Official Plan to add a definition of a public use and add a policy provision that is intended to allow public uses on lands under the ownership of, or leased by, the Corporation of the City of Brampton in all official plan land use designations within the City of Brampton.

### 2.0 LOCATION:

This amendment affects all lands within the City of Brampton identified on Schedule A to the Official Plan.

#### 3.0 AMENDMENTS AND POLICIES RELATIVE THERETO:

- 3.1 The document known as the Official Plan of the City of Brampton is hereby amended:
  - (i) by adding to Section 4.8.10 PUBLIC USES thereof, the following to the list of uses set out in Section 4.8.10.1:
    - "a protection & emergency services facility (i.e. police, fire and ambulance stations);
    - an educational facility (i.e. schools, meeting rooms and colleges)"
  - (ii) by adding to Section 4.8.10 PUBLIC USES thereof, the following new subsection as 4.8.10.2:
    - "4.8.10.2 In addition, public uses under the ownership of, or leased by, the Corporation of the City of Brampton shall be permitted in all land use designations on Schedule "A" to this Plan, subject to the City having due regard to all other relevant land use compatibility policies of this Plan and subject to conformity with Section 4.4 of this Plan, including references to Schedule "D", Environmental Features."

(iii) by adding to Section 5.2 IMPLEMENTATION thereof, the following new definition:

"Public Use shall mean uses that are owned or leased by a public authority for community, recreational, administrative, educational, health care, protection, utility or other governmental purposes, and includes accessory uses to the public use."
