



DECLARATION

I, Leonard Joseph Mikulich of the Town of Shelburne, in the County of Dufferin, do solemnly declare that:

- 1. I am the Clerk of The Corporation of the City of Brampton and as such have knowledge of the matters herein declared.
- 2. By-law 313-2005 was passed by the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton at its meeting on the 12th day of October, 2005, to adopt Amendment Number OP93-252 to the 1993 Official Plan of the City of Brampton Planning Area.
- 3. By-law 314-2005 was passed by the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton at its meeting held on the 12th day of October, 2005, to amend Zoning By-law 270-2004, as amended.
- 4. Written notice of By-law 313-2005 as required by section 17(23) and By-law 314-2005 as required by section 34(18) of the *Planning Act* was given on the 26th day of October, 2005, in the manner and in the form and to the persons and agencies prescribed by the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990 as amended.
- 5. No notice of appeal was filed under section 17(24) and section 34(19) of the *Planning Act* on or before the final date for filing objections.
- 6. In all other respects this Official Plan Amendment has been processed in accordance with all of the Planning Act requirements including regulations for notice.
- 7. OP93-252 is deemed to have come into effect on the 16th day of November, 2005, in accordance with Section 17(27) of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. 1990, as amended.
