BY-LAW

Number 316-2008

To declare surplus and authorize the sale of permanent easement rights to Hydro One Brampton Networks Inc.

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient in the interest of The Corporation of the City of Brampton that part of Block 175, Plan 43M-1409 designated as Part 1 Plan 43R-32319, part of Block 173, Plan 43M-1409 designated as Part 2, Plan 43R-32319 and part of Block 133, Plan 43M-1405 designated as Part 3, Plan 43R- 32319, be declared surplus;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to By-laws 393-2002 and 273-2005 notice of the intention to pass this by-law has been published in the Brampton Guardian newspaper a minimum of five and not more than twenty-one days prior to the Council meeting at which this by-law was considered;

AND WHEREAS the Council for the said Corporation has heard in person or by counsel, solicitor or agent, all persons claiming that their land will be prejudicially affected by this by-law and who applied to be heard;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. The permanent easement rights over Part of Block 175, Plan 43M-1409 designated as Part 1 Plan 43R-32319, part of Block 173, Plan 43R- 1409 designated as part 2 Plan 43R-32319 and part of Block 133, Plan 43M-1405, designated as Part 3 Plan 43R-32319 described in Schedule "A" to this by-law is declared surplus and transferred to Hydro One Brampton Networks Inc.
2. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to execute all documents and instruments approved by the City Solicitor as may be necessary to give effect to this by-law.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 10 day of December, 2008.
