# BY-LAW

*Number* 320-77

Being a By-law pursuant to  
Section 8 of The Expropriations  
Act.

WHEREAS the recommendation of the Inquiry Officer respecting those lands at the south-east and south-west corners of Queen Street West and McMurchy Avenue in the City of Brampton did not recommend approval of the proposed expropriation;

AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton, as the Approving Authority, shall consider the report of the Inquiry Officer and approve or not approve the expropriation;

AND WHEREAS the Approving Authority may pay costs of legal counsel up to Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00).


NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:


1. The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton, as the Approving Authority, after consideration of the report of the Inquiry Officer, does not approve of the proposed expropriations of those lands on the south-east and south-west corners of McMurchy Avenue and Queen Street West in the City of Brampton for the following reasons:

- (1) No action should be taken at this time since consideration should be given to a pending traffic operations study and hence the expropriation application is premature at this time.

2. The Treasurer is hereby authorized to pay Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) each as costs to Mr. John B. Webber, Q.C., solicitor for Harold and Doris Firth, and Mr. Christopher L. Moon, solicitor for Andrew Pace.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 19<sup>th</sup> day of December , 1977.
