A by-law to provide for the selection of City of Brampton members of the Council of the Regional Municipality of Peel

WHEREAS the *Regional Municipality of Peel Act, 2005 (Bill 186)* provides that Brampton membership on the Council of the Region of Peel shall consist of seven (7) persons, comprised of the head of Council and six other persons, and

WHEREAS this provides Brampton with one additional Regional Councillor following the 2006 election, and

WHEREAS section 4(6) of the *Regional Municipality of Peel Act, 2005 (Bill 186)* authorizes Brampton Council to determine the manner of selecting the additional Regional Councillor by December 31, 2005, and

WHEREAS the number of City and Regional Councillors was established by By-law 161-2002, and

WHEREAS Brampton Council held an open workshop on September 12, 2005 and a public town hall meeting on September 26, 2005 to solicit input from the general public, and

WHEREAS following the 2006 census, the City of Brampton intends to pursue an application to the Region of Peel for additional Regional Councillors consistent with representation by population;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. Five (5) Regional Councillors shall be elected by wards in accordance with City by-laws.
- The additional Regional Councillor shall be appointed by City Council from among the five (5) elected City Councillors following a municipal election, and that individual will then sit as a member of City and Regional Council for the full term.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 24th day of October, 2005.
