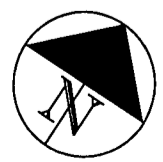


I, Leonard Joseph Mikulich of the Town of Shelburne, County of Dufferin, do solemnly declare that:
