# BY-LAW

Number 326-2011

*A By-law to amend By-Law 191-2011, as amended,  
to authorize the delegation of authority to execute  
Standard Transit Service Agreements*

**WHEREAS** By-law 191-2011 authorizes the delegation of certain powers and duties under the *Municipal Act, 2001*, the *Planning Act* and other Acts;

**AND WHEREAS** Council deems it desirable to delegate the authority to execute Standard Transit Services Agreements, defined as agreements between the Corporation of the City of Brampton and other parties, which help to improve the integration of transit services, improve connectivity between transit services, have no negative financial impact on the Corporation, and allow the Corporation to terminate the agreement within a six month time period;



**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. Schedule "A" to By-law 191-2011 is hereby amended by adding Section 11.4 as follows:

"11.4. The Commissioner of Works and Transportation or the Executive Director of Transit or his/her designate, are authorized to execute Standard Transit Service Agreements and amendments, defined as agreements between the Corporation of the City of Brampton and other parties, which help to improve the integration of transit services, improve connectivity between transit services, have no negative financial impact on the Corporation, and allow the Corporation to terminate the agreement within a six month time period, as may be required from time to time, in a form satisfactory to the City Solicitor."
