Number 329-2006

To repeal By-law 253-2006, and To prevent the application of part lot control to lot 527, Registered Plan 911

WHEREAS subsection 50(5) of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. c. P.13, as amended, has imposed part lot control on all lands within registered plans within the City;

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to subsection 50(7) of the *Planning Act*, the Council of a municipality may, by by-law, provide that subsection 50(5) of the *Planning Act* does not apply to land within such registered plan or plans of subdivision or parts thereof, as are designated in the by-law;

AND WHEREAS, on August 2, 2006, By-law 253-2006 was passed, which exempted lot 527 on Registered Plan 43M-911 from part lot control, pursuant to subsection 50(7) of the *Planning* Act, for the purpose of creating lots to facilitate the conveyance of one part of a semi-detached dwelling, but the by-law should have referred to the plan as Registered Plan 911, and therefore By-law 253-2006 should be repealed, and a new by-law passed;

AND WHEREAS, the application for an exemption from part lot control, pursuant to subsection 50(7) of the *Planning* Act, on the lands described below, for the purpose of creating lots to facilitate the conveyance of one part of a semi-detached dwelling, is to the satisfaction of the City;

NOW THEREFORE, The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton enacts as follows:

1. THAT By-law 253-2006 is hereby repealed;

2. THAT subsection 50(5) of the *Planning Act* does not apply to the following lands:

City of Brampton, Regional Municipality of Peel, being composed of:

The whole of lot 527 on Registered Plan 911; and,

3. THAT, pursuant to subsection 50(7.3) of the *Planning Act*, this by-law shall expire at the end of the business day on September 25, 2009.

READ a **FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME** and **CASSED** in Open Council this 25th day of September, 2006.
