

## THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON

## BY-LAW

Number331 - 2006
To prevent the application of part lot control to part of Registered Plan <b>43M-1678</b>
WHEREAS subsection 50(5) of the <i>Planning Act</i> , R.S.O. c. P.13, as amended, has imposed part
ot control on all lands within registered plans within the City;
AND WHEREAS, pursuant to subsection 50(7) of the <i>Planning Act</i> , the Council of a municipality may, by by-law, provide that subsection 50(5) of the <i>Planning Act</i> does not apply to
and within such registered plan or plans of subdivision or parts thereof, as are designated in the by-law;

**AND WHEREAS**, the application for an exemption from part lot control, pursuant to subsection 50(7) of the *Planning Act*, on the lands described below, for the purpose of creating maintenance easements in association with detached dwelling units on Lots 212, 215, 216, 218, 219, 227, 228, 230, 246, 268, 315, 357, 368, 371, 374 380, 392, and 399, is to the satisfaction of the City of Brampton;

**NOW THEREFORE,** The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:** 

1. THAT subsection 50(5) of the *Planning Act* does not apply to the following lands:

City of Brampton, Regional Municipality of Peel, being composed of:

Lots 212, 215, 216, 218, 219, 227, 228, 230, 246, 268, 315, 357, 368, 371, 374, 380, 392, and 399 on Registered Plan 43M-1678.

2. THAT, pursuant to subsection 50(7.3) of the *Planning Act*, this by-law shall expire on September 25, 2009.

**READ** a **FIRST**, **SECOND** and **THIRD TIME** and **PASSED** in Open Council this 25<sup>th</sup> day of September 2006.
