A By-Law to Revoke Deputy Treasurer and Acting Treasurer Appointments AND to Appoint Three New Deputy Treasurers

WHEREAS subsection 286(2) of the *Municipal Act*, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended, authorizes the Council of a municipality to appoint Deputy Treasurers;

AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton seeks to appoint three Deputy Treasurers;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

Revocation of Previous Appointments

- 1. That By-Law 20-2000, passed on January 31, 2000, appointing Peter E. Honeyborne as Deputy Treasurer for the City of Brampton be and is repealed.
- 2. That By-Law 56-2002, passed on February 25, 2002, appointing Bonnie Eskelson as Acting Treasurer for the City of Brampton be and is repealed.

Deputy Treasurer Appointments

- 3. That PETER E. HONEYBORNE be and is appointed Deputy Treasurer (First) for the City of Brampton, and shall exercise all powers and duties of the Treasurer, as required and during the absence of the Treasurer.
- 4. That DONALD McFARLANE be and is appointed Deputy Treasurer (Second) for the City of Brampton, and shall exercise all powers and duties of the Treasurer, as required and during the absence of the Treasurer and the Deputy Treasurer (First).
- 5. That BONNIE ESKELSON be and is appointed Deputy Treasurer (Third) for the City of Brampton, and shall exercise all powers and duties of the Treasurer, as required and during the absence of the Treasurer, the Deputy Treasurer (First) and the Deputy Treasurer (Second).

Effective Date

6. This By-law comes into effect on the date it is passed by Council.
