# AMENDMENT NUMBER OP93- **335**TO THE OFFICIAL PLAN OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON PLANNING AREA

#### 1.0 Purpose:

The purpose of this amendment is to delete the "Minor Collector Road Access" designation on the east side of Torbram Road, north of Sandalwood Parkway as shown on Schedule SP 28(A).

#### 2.0 Location:

The lands subject to this amendment are located on the east side of Torbram Road, north of Sandalwood Parkway. The subject lands are located in Part of Lot 14, Concession 6, East of Hurontario Street in the City of Brampton.

### 3.0 Amendments and Policies Relative Thereto:


- 3.1 The document known as the Official Plan of the City of Brampton Planning Area is hereby amended:

- 3.2 The portions of the document known as the 1984 Official Plan of the City of Brampton Planning Area, which remain in force and as they relate to the Sandringham-Wellington Secondary Plan (being Chapter 28 of Part IV Secondary Plans, as amended) are hereby further amended:
  - (1) by deleting on Schedule SP 28(A) thereto, the "Minor Collector Road Access" as shown on the east side of Torbram Road, north of Sandalwood Parkway.

#### **DECLARATION**

I, LEONARD JOSEPH MIKULICH, of the Town of Shelburne, in the County of Dufferin, DO SOLEMNLY DECLARE THAT:

- 1. I am the Clerk of The Corporation of the City of Brampton and as such have knowledge of the matters herein declared.
- 2. By-law 337-2003 was passed by the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton at its meeting on the 27<sup>th</sup> day of October, 2003, to adopt Amendment Number OP93-225 to the 1993 Official Plan of the City of Brampton Planning Area.
- 3. By-law 338-2003 was passed by the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton at its meeting held on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of October, 2003, to amend Comprehensive Zoning By-law 151-88, as amended.
- 4. Written notice of By-law 337-2003 as required by section 17(23) and By-law 338-2003 as required by section 34(18) of the *Planning Act* was given on the 6<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2003, in the manner and in the form and to the persons and agencies prescribed by the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990 as amended.
- 5. No notice of appeal was filed under sections 17(24) and 34(19) of the *Planning Act* on or before the final date for filing objections.
- 6. In all other respects this Official Plan Amendment has been processed in accordance with all of the Planning Act requirements including regulations for notice.
- 7. OP93-225 is deemed to have come into effect on the 27<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2003, in accordance with Section 17(27) of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. 1990, as amended.
