



THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON

BY-LAW

Number 345-2012

To prevent the application of part lot control to
part of Registered Plan 43M - 1899

WHEREAS subsection 50(5) of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. c. P.13, as amended, has imposed part lot control on all lands within registered plans within the City;

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to subsection 50(7) of the *Planning Act*, the Council of a municipality may, by by-law, provide that subsection 50(5) of the *Planning Act* does not apply to land within such registered plan or plans of subdivision or parts thereof, as are designated in the by-law;

AND WHEREAS, the application for an exemption from part lot control, pursuant to subsection 50(7) of the *Planning Act*, on the lands described below, for the purpose of creating maintenance easements is to the satisfaction of the City of Brampton;

NOW THEREFORE, The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. THAT subsection 50(5) of the *Planning Act* does not apply to the following lands:


City of Brampton, Regional Municipality of Peel, being composed of:


The whole of Lots 1, and 4 to 9, inclusive, 11, 12, 13, 15, 16, 18, 19, 21, 22, 24, 25, 27, 28, 30, 31, 33, 34, 36, 37, 39, 40, 42, 43, 45, 46, 50, 51, 53, 54, and 57 to 60, inclusive, 62, 63, 65, 66, 68, 69, 71, 72, 74, and 75 and Blocks 95 and 96 on Registered Plan 43M-1899.


2. THAT, pursuant to subsection 50(7.3) of the *Planning Act*, this by-law shall expire at the end of the business day on November 28, 2015.
