A by-law to amend Procedure By-law 160-2004, as amended

WHEREAS By-law 160-2004 provides rules governing the order and proceedings of the council and committees of the council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton; and

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to Committee of Council Recommendation CW086-2005 approved by City Council on February 28, 2005, it is deemed appropriate to amend By-law 160-2004;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

- 1. That By-law 160-2004 is hereby amended as follows:
  - a. To delete subsection 4.5(8)(a) and to substitute the following:
    - "4.5(8)(a) A delegation regarding a matter for which there is no staff report on the agenda for that meeting shall be received without comment by members on the subject and the matter shall be referred to staff for a report, unless there is a majority vote to simply "receive" the delegation."
  - b. To delete subsection 4.5(2) and to substitute the following:
    - "4.5(2)(a) Every request to be a delegation shall be received by the Clerk no later than 4:30 p.m. on the Tuesday of the week preceding the meeting, and shall include the complete name, address, telephone number, and/or email address, of the person requesting the opportunity to be a delegation, as well as the reasons for the delegation, and, if applicable, the name, address and telephone number of any person, corporation or organization represented.
      - (b) Notwithstanding subsection (a) above, no delegation shall be permitted when the subject matter to be addressed relates to a recommendation of any tribunal that has conducted a hearing under the *Statutory Powers Procedure Act*."
