BY-LAW

Number 355-2002

To prohibit the sounding of train engine whistles at the crossing Mississauga Road and Heritage Road

WHEREAS by Resolution C408-2002 passed November 25, 2002, Council resolved that the sounding of engine whistles under Rule 14(L)(ii) of the Canadian Rail Operating Rules be prohibited at the crossing of Mi. 19.17 Halton Subdivision – Mississauga Road and Mi. 20.14 Halton Subdivision – Heritage Road;

AND WHEREAS Council wishes to confirm this resolution by passage of a by-law;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The sounding of engine whistles under Rule 14(L)(ii) of the Canadian Rail Operating Rules at the crossing of Mi. 19.17 Halton Subdivision – Mississauga Road is hereby prohibited.
2. The sounding of engine whistles under Rule 14(L)(ii) of the Canadian Rail Operating Rules at the crossing of Mi. 20.14 Halton Subdivision – Heritage Road is hereby prohibited.
