
To amend By-law 270-2004, as amended

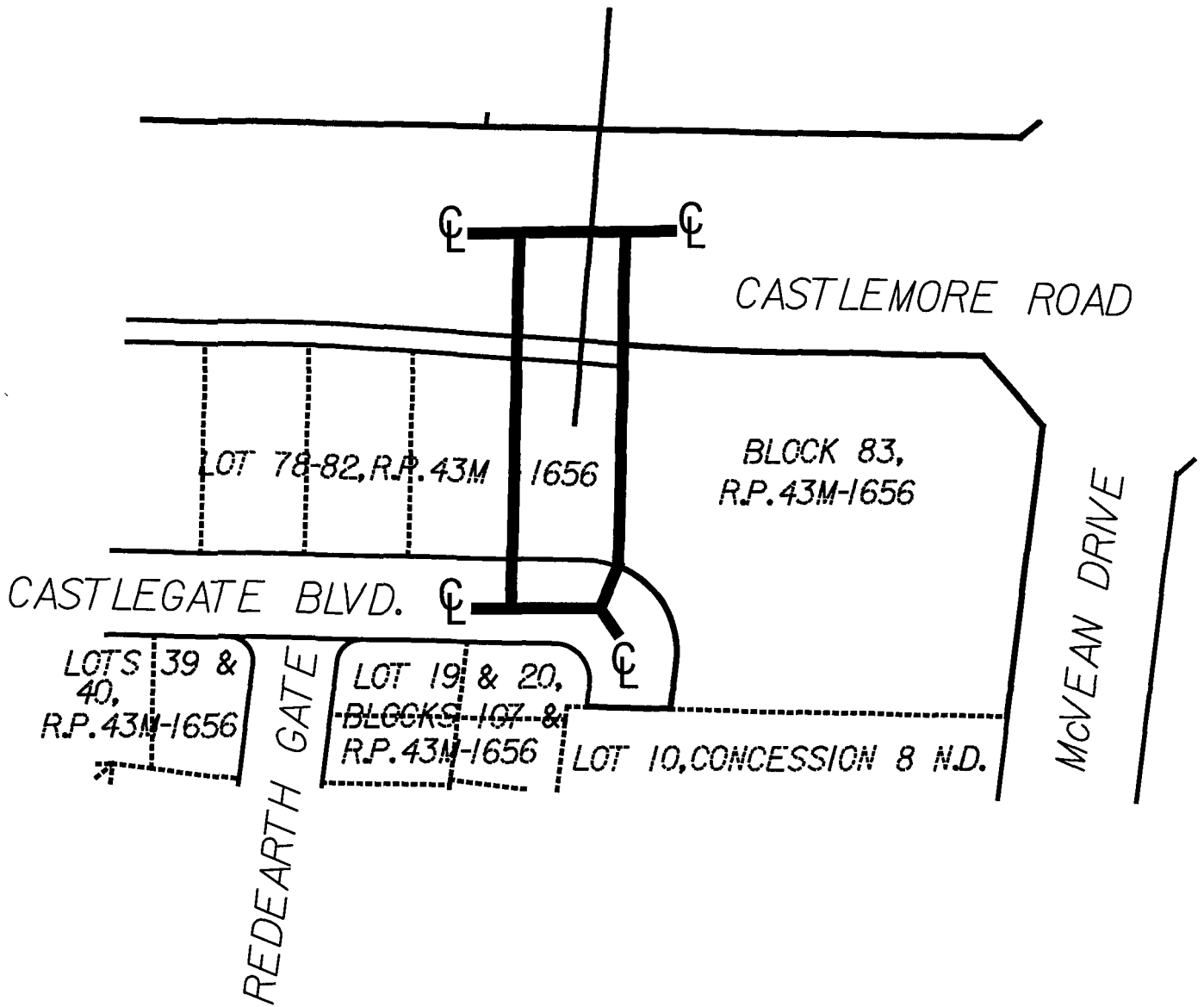

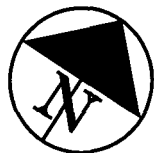


LEGEND

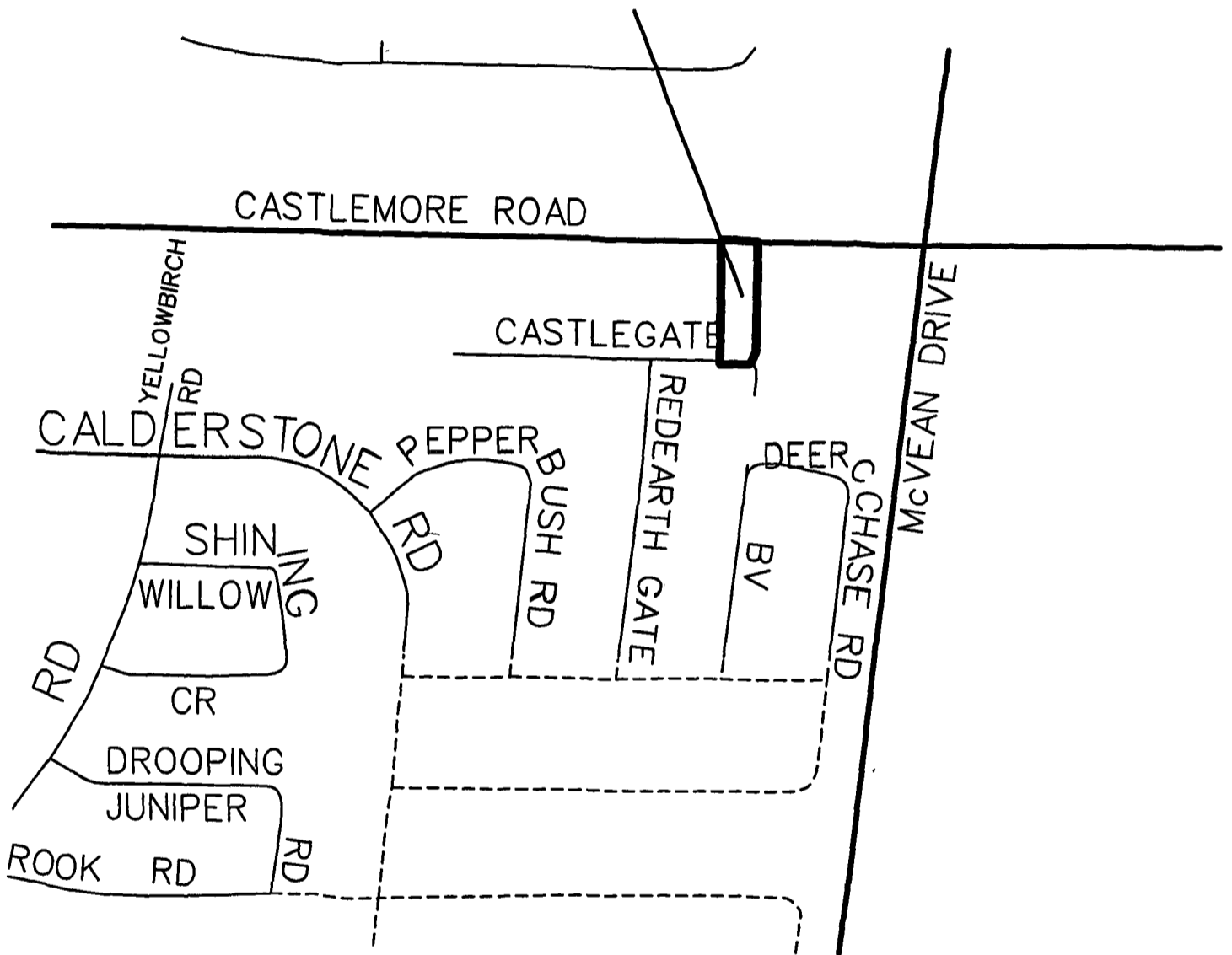

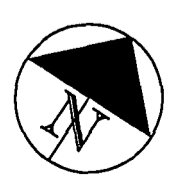


DECLARATION
