

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON

BY-LAW

Number 360 - 2007

To authorize the purchase of certain lands from Gurdarshan Brar and Paramjit Brar for road widening purposes.

Section 6 of the <u>Municipal Act 2001</u> authorizes the Council of every corporation to pass a by-law for acquiring or expropriating any land required for the purposes of the corporation. The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton has determined that it is necessary and in the interest of The Corporation of the City of Brampton to acquire the lands herein described for road widening purposes.

NOW THEREFORE The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

- 1. The purchase of the lands described as part of Lot 14, Concession 4, East of Hurontario Street, designated as Part 20 on Plan 43R –30957, in the City of Brampton, for the purposes of widening Bramalea Road, is hereby authorized.
- 2. The Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized to execute on behalf of The Corporation of the City of Brampton an agreement of purchase and sale, in a form approved by the City Solicitor, between vendors, Gurdarshan Brar and Paramjit Brar and purchaser, The Corporation of the City of Brampton, together with all other documents that in the opinion of the City Solicitor are necessary to effect the purchase of the said land.
- 3. The funds for the acquisition shall be taken from capital project account # 074020-001 Land Acquisition.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 14th day of November, 2007.
