WHEREAS subsection 50(5) of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. c. P.13, as amended, has imposed part lot control on all lands within registered plans within the City;

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to subsection 50(7) of the *Planning Act*, the Council of a municipality may, by by-law, provide that subsection 50(5) of the *Planning Act* does not apply to land within such registered plan or plans of subdivision or parts thereof, as are designated in the by-law;

AND WHEREAS, the application for an exemption from part lot control, pursuant to subsection 50(7) of the *Planning* Act, on the lands described below for the purpose of creating maintenance easements, is to the satisfaction of the City of Brampton;

NOW THEREFORE, The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. **THAT** subsection 50(5) of the Planning Act does not apply to the following lands:

City of Brampton, Regional Municipality of Peel, being composed of:

The whole of lots 10, 116, 117, 120, 121, 122, 132, 133, 136, 137, 140, 141, 142, 144, 147, 150, 151, 154 and 155 on Registered Plan 43M-1697;

2. THAT, pursuant to subsection 50(7.3) of the *Planning Act*, this by-law shall expire on October 11th, 2009 at the end of the business day

READ a **FIRST**, **SECOND** and **THIRD TIME** and **PASSED** in Open Council this 11th day of October 2006.
