Number 370 - 2012

To amend By-law 399-2002, as amended,
The Sign By-law

WHEREAS a ground sign installed at May-Van Plaza encroaches onto public property; and

WHEREAS an encroachment agreement has been secured with the Region of Peel; and

WHEREAS no safety concerns were identified with the proposed location of the ground sign.


NOW THEREFORE The Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows.


THAT By-law 399-2002, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding the following sentence to Schedule XIII SITE SPECIFIC PROVISIONS.


34. Notwithstanding Section 5.(5) and Schedule II GROUND SIGNS, Sentence 2.(5) the following signage on the lands described as PLAN M1748 BLK 577 (527-537 Van Kirk Drive) is permitted:


- a) One ground sign on Mayfield Road setback 0 m from the property line provided an encroachment agreement is entered into with the Region of Peel.
