1. By-law 93-93, as amended, is hereby further amended as follows:

(1) by adding to Schedule X thereto the following items:

COLUMN 1 HIGHWAY	COLUMN 2 RATE OF SPEED	COLUMN 3 BETWEEN	COLUMN 4 TIMES OR DAYS
MacKay Street North	40	A point 57 metres north of Manitou Crescent and a point 158 metres south of Massey Street	Anytime

READ a FIRST, SECOND, and THIRD TIME and PASSED in OPEN COUNCIL, this 8th day of NOVEMBER, 2004.

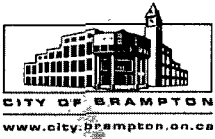

The following recommendation of the Committee of Council Meeting of November 3, 2004 was approved by Council on November 8, 2004:

E 3-1. Notice of Motion by Regional Councillor Miles, re: **Implementing a 40 km/hour Speed Zone on MacKay Street at Massey Street for the Safe Crossing of Students Attending Massey Public School – Ward 7** (File T35).

The following motion will be considered at the next Committee of Council Meeting scheduled to be held on November 17, 2004:

“Whereas Massey Public School is located just east of MacKay Street and Massey Street; and,

“Whereas MacKay Street at Massey Street is a major 4-lane arterial road that is a major crossing route for students attending Massey Public School; and,

“Whereas City Policy only allows for 40 km/hour speed zones directly in front of schools;

“Therefore Be It Resolved, that a 40 km/hour speed zone be implemented on MacKay Street at Massey Street, recognizing the need to slow down traffic to allow for the safe crossing of the many young children attending Massey Public School.”
