Number 379-2004

To authorize surplus lands and
transfer of an easement

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient in the interest of The Corporation of the City of Brampton that the City transfer an easement over lands described as Part of Lot 14, Concession 3 E.H.S. designated as Parts 1, 10, 15 and 26 on Plan 43R-28978 and Part of Lot 13, Concession 3 E.H.S. designated as Part 6 on Plan 43R-21351 (the "Lands") in exchange for a release of an existing easement over lands described as Part of Lot 14, Concession 3 E.H.S. designated as Part 5 on Plan 43R-21351 and Part of Lot 13, Concession 3 E.H.S. designated as Part 6 on Plan 43R-21351 ("Released Easement Lands");

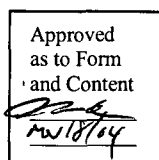
AND WHEREAS the procedures required by section 268 of the *Municipal Act, 2001* have been carried out;

AND WHEREAS the Council The Corporation of the City of Brampton has heard in person or by counsel, solicitor or agent, all persons claiming that their land will be prejudicially affected by this by-law and who applied to be heard;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. The Lands are hereby declared to be surplus.
2. The transfer of easement over the Lands in exchange for the Released Easement Lands is hereby authorized and the City Solicitor is hereby authorized to execute all documents and instruments as may be necessary to effect the transfer of the said lands.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 13th day of December, 2004.
