


THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON





To exempt from City taxation, Branches 15 and 609 of the Royal Canadian Legion Repeals By-law 171-99

WHEREAS Section 6.1 (1) of the Assessment Act, R.S.O. 1990, c. A.31 and amendments thereto, permits a municipality to exempt from taxation, other than school taxes and local improvement rates, for a period not exceeding ten (10) years, any land that is used and occupied as a memorial home, clubhouse, or athletic grounds by persons who served in the armed forces of Her Majesty or Her Majesty's allies in any war;

AND WHEREAS the Council wishes to provide a tax exemption from City taxation;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton hereby ENACTS as follows:

- 1. That the Treasurer is authorized to allow a tax exemption from City taxation on the land occupied by the Royal Canadian Legion, Branch 15 at 80 Mary St, and on the land occupied Royal Canadian Legion, Branch 609 at 1133 Queen Street East, provided that:
 - 1.1.the land is used and occupied as a clubhouse by persons who served in the armed forces of Her Majesty or Her Majesty's allies in war;
 - 1.2. the exemption does not include local improvement charges and taxes levied for school purposes
- 2. That this By-law hereby repeal By-law #171-99.
- 3. That this By-law shall remain in force from year to year until repealed, but shall not remain in force after the year 2017.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this **28** day of **November** ²⁰⁰⁷.
