Number 384-2003

To authorize surplus lands and transfer of an easement to The Regional Municipality of Peel

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient in the interest of The Corporation of the City of Brampton that the City transfer an easement over Part of the original road allowance between Concessions 2 and 3, East of Hurontario Street being Part of Part 9 on 43R-25657 shown as Part 1 on a draft reference plan by Donald E Roberts, O.L.S. ref. No. 03-5953-2 dated December 8, 2003 (the "Lands") to The Regional Municipality of Peel;



AND WHEREAS the procedures required by section 268 of the *Municipal Act, 2001* have been carried out;




NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. The Lands are hereby declared to be surplus.
2. The transfer of easement for nominal consideration over the Lands to The Regional Municipality of Peel is hereby authorized and the City Solicitor is hereby authorized to execute all documents and instruments as may be necessary to effect the transfer of easement of the said lands.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 15th day of December, 2003.
