To amend By-law 102-2006, as amended, Being an Interim Control By-law Applicable to Part of the Area Subject to Zoning By-law 270-2004

The Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

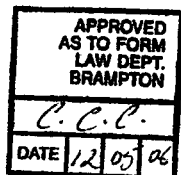
1. By-law 102-2006, as amended, is hereby further amended:
 - (1) by deleting in Section 1, the words "and 1.5," and replacing them with the following:

"1.5, and, 1.6,"
 - (2) by adding to Section 1 the following:

"1.6 The lands described as municipally 148 Queen Street East within Part of Lot 6, Concession 1, E.H.S., municipally known as and referenced as the "Lands Subject to Specific Exemption from Interim Control By-law 102-2006, as amended, by By-law 388-2006", as outlined on Schedule 'A' to this By-law, may permit a personal service shop use."
 - (3) by deleting Schedule 'A' thereto and replacing it with the Schedule 'A' attached to this By-law.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME, and PASSED in OPEN COUNCIL,

this 13 day of December 2006.

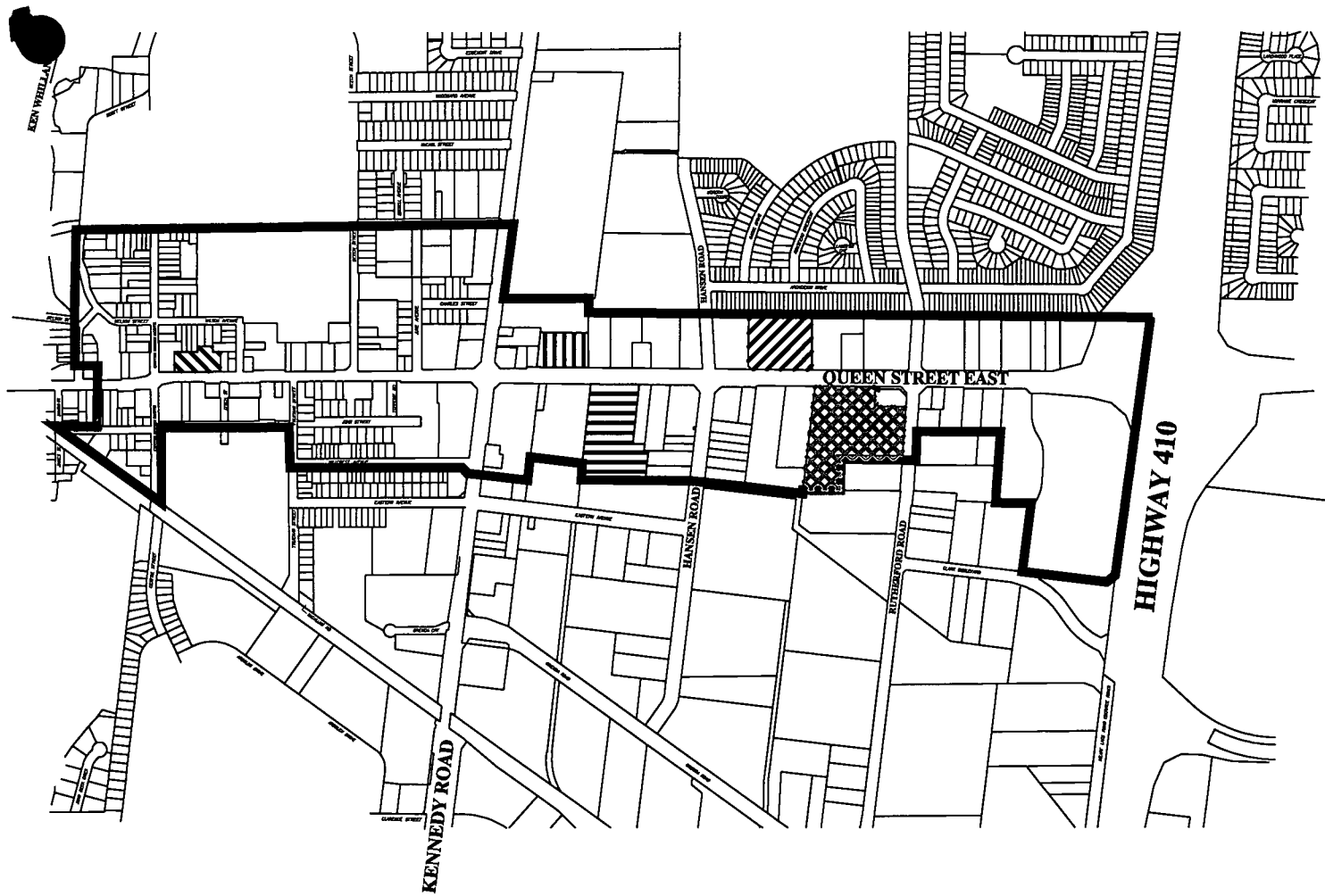


DECLARATION
