> To amend By-law 200-96, as amended, respecting the Brampton Clean City Committee

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton enacted By-law 200-96, to establish and create terms of reference and the composition of the Brampton Clean City Committee;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to Recommendation BCC009-2002, approved by Council on December 18, 2002, it is deemed expedient to decrease the membership of the Brampton Clean City Committee and to change the membership status of the City and Regional Councillors on the Committee;

AND WHEREAS it is expedient to make some housekeeping amendments to the by-law to reflect the current operation of the Committee;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

- By-law 200-96, as amended, is hereby further amended as follows:
 - Section 1 (a) is amended by changing nine (9) to seven (7). (1)
 - Sections 1 (b) and (c) are deleted and the following substituted therefor: (2)
 - one City Councillor who shall be a liaison member and as such shall not be counted as part of quorum for the Committee."
 - one Regional Councillor who shall be a liaison member and as such shall "(c) not be counted as part of quorum for the Committee."
 - (3) Section 3 is deleted and the following substituted therefor:
 - "3. Appointments under Sections 1 (a), (b) and (c) shall be made by resolution of City Council for a term of office to run concurrently with the term of office for City Council."
 - (4) Section 4 is deleted and the following substituted therefor:
 - At the first meeting of each term of office, members of the Brampton Clean City Committee shall elect a Chair and Vice-Chair."
