# BY-LAW

Number 391-2005

To prevent the application of part lot control to  
part of Registered Plan 43M - 1667

**WHEREAS** subsection 50(5) of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. c. P.13, as amended, has imposed part lot control on all lands within registered plans within the City;

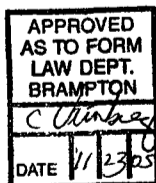
**AND WHEREAS**, pursuant to subsection 50(7) of the *Planning Act*, the Council of a municipality may, by by-law, provide that subsection 50(5) of the *Planning Act* does not apply to land within such registered plan or plans of subdivision or parts thereof, as are designated in the by-law;

**AND WHEREAS**, the application for an exemption from part lot control, pursuant to subsection 50(7) of the *Planning Act*, on the lands described below, for the purpose of creating maintenance easements to facilitate single detached dwelling units, is to the satisfaction of the City of Brampton;

**NOW THEREFORE**, The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. THAT subsection 50(5) of the *Planning Act* does not apply to the following lands:  
  
City of Brampton, Regional Municipality of Peel, being composed of:  
  
The whole of Lots 341, 345, 350, 357, 360, 362, 364, 366, 368, and 370 on Registered Plan 43M-1667.
2. THAT, pursuant to subsection 50(7.3) of the *Planning Act*, this by-law shall expire on November 28<sup>th</sup>, 2006.

**READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED** in Open Council this 28<sup>th</sup> day of November 2005.
