

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON

BY-LAW

Number 394-2003

To authorize surplus lands and transfers of an easement to Bell Canada and Hydro One Brampton Networks Inc.

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient in the interest of The Corporation of the City of Brampton that the City transfer easements over Part of Blocks 114 and 99, 43M-1378 as shown as Parts 2 and 3 on a draft reference plan by R. Salna, O.L.S. File: 01-053 CAD File: Castlemore3-Hydro Easement2 (the "Lands") to Bell Canada and Hydro One Brampton Networks Inc.;

AND WHEREAS the procedures required by section 268 of the *Municipal Act*, 2001 have been carried out;

AND WHEREAS the Council The Corporation of the City of Brampton has heard in person or by counsel, solicitor or agent, all persons claiming that their land will be prejudicially affected by this by-law and who applied to be heard;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS**:

- 1. The Lands are hereby declared to be surplus.
- 2. The transfers of easement for nominal consideration over the Lands to Bell Canada and Hydro One Brampton Networks Inc. are hereby authorized and the City Solicitor is hereby authorized to execute all documents and instruments as may be necessary to effect the transfer of easement of the said lands.

READ a **FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME** and **PASSED** in Open Council this $15^{\rm th}$ day of December, 2003.
