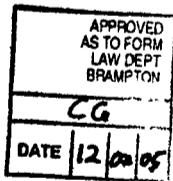


1. By-law 270-2004, as amended, is hereby further amended:
