

### **NOTICE OF INTENTION TO STOP UP AND CLOSE, DECLARE SURPLUS, AND DISPOSE OF MUNICIPAL PROPERTIES**

**PURSUANT** to By-law 160-2004, take notice that The Corporation of the City of Brampton intends to consider the following actions with regard to municipal properties:

**1. To stop up and close, declare surplus, and dispose of an untravelled portion of Torbram Road, north of Steeles Avenue East, Ward 8**

Part of the westerly half of original Torbram Road right-of-way, approximately 0.04 acre in size (1,847 sq. ft.)

**2. To declare surplus and dispose of permanent easement rights over municipal property at Creditview/Sandalwood Park**

Transfer of an additional 10 metre wide permanent easement to TransCanada Pipelines Limited, being Part 3 on Plan 43R-34579, for the twinning of its pipeline from Steeles Avenue West to Creditview Road. Temporary easement rights are also being granted but not transferred.

**3. To declare surplus and dispose of a residual land parcel, south side of Castlemore Road, east of Clarkway Drive, Ward 10**

A vacant land parcel, approximately 0.26 acre in size, being Part of Lot 10, Concession 11, N.D., City of Brampton

City Council will consider these matters on August 8, 2012 at 1:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers, Brampton City Hall, at the address noted below. Anyone wishing to be heard regarding these matters should contact the Clerk's Office or provide written comments on or before 4:30 p.m., August 7, 2012. In the event that the Committee chooses to defer consideration of the matter, no further public notice will be given.
