

DISPOSITION OF LAND

EXPLANATORY NOTE

Transfer of those portions of Fogel Road, Castlemore Road and Cottrell Boulevard that lie within the jurisdiction of the Region of Peel for the reconstruction and widening of Highway 50 from Queen Street West to Castlemore Road.

Pursuant to By-law 191-2011, surplus declaration may be made by Delegated Authority. In this case, authority is delegated to the City Solicitor and the Commissioner of Works & Transportation for the following circumstance:

- Surplus declaration of property or rights to be conveyed to a utility for installation / maintenance of services, or for property or right to be conveyed to another government.
